Coastal Carolina Chapter MOAA Scholarship Guidelines

1. Scholarships will be awarded to dependents of *Retired U.S. Uniformed Services* personnel living in Carteret, Craven, Jones or Pamlico Counties, or dependents of *Active Duty U.S. Uniformed Services* personnel permanently assigned to a command within the ABOVE FOUR (4) county area. Deployed military must be permanently assigned to a command within the above four (4) county areas.
2. The applicant must complete the 12th grade and receive a diploma; or, be currently enrolled in a four year college/university; or will attend his/her first or second year at a community college enrolled in a course of study leading to an associates degree or the declared intent to transfer to a four year college/university to complete degree requirements. Graduate degree students are not eligible for this program. Applicants may be accepted to any accredited college, university, or community college. Applicants are not required to attend a college or university in North Carolina.
3. Applicants must be enrolled as a "Full – Time Student". (Minimum of 12 credit hours).
4. The scholarship may be based on financial need; however, all-around excellence in academics, civic and social activities, will be instrumental in the selection process.
5. Applicant must:
 - A. Provide a certified copy high school, community college, or college/university transcript.
 - B. Provide SAT / ACT score results; high school grade point average, and class standing.
 - C. Provide certified copy of community college or college/university letter of acceptance.
 - D. Provide a statement of commitment by the applicant to attend the selected community college or college/university.
 - E. Provide a resume of Major or skill areas to be studied and degree planned.
 - F. Provide confirmation of credit hours enrolled in a selected community college or college/university.
 - G. Provide a list of current and past organizational affiliations, activities and responsibilities.
 - H. Provide two current, dated personal letters of reference/recommendation. Persons writing letters must not be related to the applicant. Letters include writers name, occupation, home address and telephone number.
 - I. Provide an essay of 500 words or less which includes:
 1. Why you have chosen your selected profession?
 2. What are your plans for the future?
 3. Why you should be awarded this scholarship?
6. Scholarship winners may reapply each year while pursuing undergraduate studies.
7. Applications and supporting information, once submitted, become the property of CC/MOA Scholarship Committee. Applicants should rest assured scholarship applications will be treated as privileged information and will not be released without applicants' consent.
8. The Coastal Carolina Chapter of the Military Officers Association of America maintains a policy of non-discrimination; therefore, scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, religion, age, sex, handicap or national origin.
9. Applications and supporting documents must be postmarked no later than 5 April of the year for which applying and forwarded to:
