CenturyLink SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. Scholarships will be awarded to dependents of Active Duty military personnel assigned to any military organization stationed at MCAS Cherry Point, North Carolina. Dependents of deployed military members permantely assigned to military organizations at MCAS Cherry Point may also apply
2. Scholarship winners must be accepted to attend an accredited four year college or university. The applicant may attend any accredited four year college or university in or out of the State of North Carolina.
3. Dependents attending a community college that have been accepted to attend a four year college or university are eligible to apply.
4. Scholarships will be awarded to students based on all – around excellence in academics, athletics, civic and social activities.
5. Financial need WILL NOT necessarily be a criterion for selection.
6. Applicant must provide the following:
 - a. Certified copy of high school (or GED certification), community colleger or college/university transcript.
 - b. SAT / ACT score results; high school grade point average, and class standing.
 - c. Certified copy of college or university letter of acceptance.
 - d. Statement of commitment to attend the selected college or university.
 - e. Resume of major or skill area to be studied and degree earned.
 - f. Resume of past and current organizational affiliations, activities, awards, and responsibilities.
 - g. Two current, dated personnel letters of recommendation Persons writing the letters must not be related to the applicant. Letters should include writers name, occupation, address and telephone number.
 - h. Essay of 500 words that includes:
 - Why you have chosen your selected profession?
 - What are your plans for the future?
 - Why you should be awarded this scholarship?
7. The CenturyLink CCC/MOAA Scholarship Committee will select the recipients each year. This will be a one time award; however, previous scholarship winners are eligible to apply for additional scholarships in subsequent years while pursuing undergraduate studies (application requirements remain the same).
8. In keeping with CenturyLink and the Coastal Carolina Chapter of the Military Officers Association of America policy of non-discrimination, scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, color, religion, age, sex, handicap or national origin.

9. Application and supporting documents must be postmarked no later than 5 April of the year for which applying.
