# Guidelines

1. One (1) \$1000 Scholarship will be awarded to a Senior JROTC High School Student who is a dependent of an active duty or retired military service member. The student must be living *in and attending High School in Carteret, Craven, Jones, Beaufort or Pamlico Counties*,
2. The applicants must complete the 12<sup>th</sup> grade, receive a diploma and will be attending his/her year at a college, university, or community college, enrolled in a course of study leading to an associate's degree or the declared intent to transfer to a four-year college or university to complete degree requirements. Applicants may be accepted to any accredited college, university, or community college. Applicants are not required to attend a college, university, or community college in North Carolina.
3. Applicants must be enrolled as a "Full – Time Student". (Minimum of 12 credit hours).
4. The scholarship may be based on financial need; however, all-around excellence in academics, civic and social activities, will be instrumental in the selection process.
5. Applicant must:
  - A. Provide a sealed, certified copy of high school, community college, or college/university transcripts. (Both if dual enrolled)
  - B. Provide SAT / ACT score results. (*This requirement has been cancelled for the 2021 applications due to the Covid-19-based changes made in many college and university admission requirements.*)**
  - C. Provide certified copy of community college college or university letter of acceptance.
  - D. Provide a personal statement describing Major or skill areas to be studied and degree planned.
  - E. Provide a list of current and past organizational affiliations, activities and responsibilities.
  - F. Provide two current, dated personal letters of reference/recommendation. Persons writing letters **must not** be related to the applicant. Letters must include writers name, occupation, home address and telephone number.
  - G. Provide an essay of 500 words or less which includes:
    1. Why have you chosen your selected profession?
    2. What are your plans for the future?
    3. Why you should be awarded this scholarship?
6. Applications and supporting information, once submitted, become the property of CC/MOA Scholarship Committee. Applicants should rest assured your scholarship application will be treated as privileged information and will not be released without applicants' consent.
7. The Coastal Carolina Chapter of the Military Officers Association of America maintains a policy of non-discrimination; therefore, the scholarship is awarded without regard to race, color, religion, age, sex, disability, or national origin.
8. Applications and supporting documents must be postmarked no later than **5 April of the year for which applying and forwarded to:**
